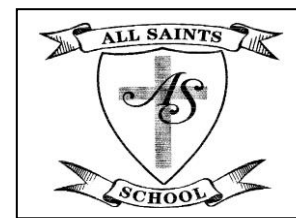

### SUN PROTECTION

Now that the summer months are upon us, with the possibility of longer hours of sunshine, we should think about how we protect our children from the harmful rays of the sun that can lead to problems with skin cancer later in life.

- Try to ensure that as much of your child's body as possible (and practical) is covered with clothing. PE shirts should cover the shoulders, so vests or tops with shoulder straps are not suitable. Provide your child with a sun-hat, preferably one that protects the ears and neck.
- Please provide your child with sun cream of at least factor 30. Apply it yourself before the child leaves for school (if the weather forecast warrants it). Train your children to apply it themselves at lunchtime. Please do not send spray-bottles as there is a danger of squirting it in the eyes. Bottles or tubes should be marked with your child's name.
- Please ensure that your child has a water bottle in school.
- We will encourage children to make use of the shade around the grounds and provide information on sun-safety in class.
